The conference aims to bring together those students and fellow researchers interested in sustainability who would like to present new research, exchange information, and discuss the current issues.

As a responsible University and signatory of PRME (Principles for Responsible Management Education) and also member of the European School of Sustainability Science and Research ([ESSSR network](#)) Budapest Business School's Centre of Excellence for Sustainability Impacts in Business and Society (CESIBUS) cordially invite all bachelor, master, and PhD students to conduct an independent research in the following practice-oriented topics:

- **Sustainability in SMEs** – how the business deals with these challenges
- **Sustainable Business Models**– how this approach (e.g. circular or sharing economy, social entrepreneurship etc.) can be the solution for global sustainability issues
- **Stakeholder engagement** – how the sectors (incl. HEI) can operate an efficient stakeholder approach
- **Sustainable and responsible hospitality and tourism** – how the players of the industry can have an impact by putting special emphasis on this key topic
- **The importance of education** – how the industries can help increase the level of sustainability knowledge and consciousness of stakeholders/consumers
- **Contribution of NGOs and NPOs** – what is the role of them in terms of societal, environmental an economic impact



- **Conscious consumption** – how the consumer groups can help each other have a more sustainable/responsible way of life

What and when?

1. You are invited to register and submit your abstract for BBS Sustainability Conference. Send your abstract to Dorina Körtvési via email kortvesi.dorina@uni-bge.hu

 - **Abstract submission deadline: 1st April 2022**
 - Important note: when sending the paper, please, have concrete research and/or presentation title, your name, e-mail address and institution!
2. Present your research results in 15 minutes to our business/academic/NGO partners and spread the word at BBS Sustainability Conference on 22nd April 2022

How to write your abstract?

- Abstracts should be written in English, the official language of the event. It should be up to 250 words, written concisely and clearly. The abstract should reflect your planned research on what will appear in your research paper. Please divide the abstract into these headings:
 - Author (s) name, faculty, university, email
 - Title of the paper- the title should be as simple, clear, and precise as possible
 - Purpose - What are the objectives of your research? What are your research questions?
- Design/methodology/approach - How are the objectives achieved? Include the main scientific method(s) used in your research. What is the approach to the topic and what is the theoretical or subject scope of the paper?
- Findings - What are the expected research results?



- Practical implications - What outcomes and implications for practice, applications and consequences will be identified? How will the research impact the business or enterprise? What changes to practice should be made as a result of this research? What will be the commercial or economic impact?
- Social implications - What will be the impact on society of this research? How will it influence public attitudes? How will it influence (corporate) social responsibility or environmental issues? How could it inform public or industry policy? How might it affect the quality of life?
- Originality/value - What will be new in your research paper? Why and to whom may your research be valuable?

How to conduct your scientific research?

1. Choose one of the research topics/questions listed above that interests you or that you find yourself drawn to.
2. Specify your research question. The research question will be the primary focus of your study. Once you have chosen a topic that interests you, investigate some of the unanswered questions within that field.
3. Perform a comprehensive literature search. Find and read articles in the field related to the research question you have identified. Synthesize previous research findings related to your chosen research topic / question.
4. Determine what research method (s) you would like to apply to answer your research questions.
5. Plan and conduct your research
6. Write your research paper.

How to write your research paper?

We ask you to comply with the following formal requirements:

- The length of the research papers should be between 10-15 pages, not including the bibliography and any appendices. Scientific research is highly recommended but literature reviews as part of researches are appreciated as well.
- All the text must be in one column and Arial font, including figures and tables, with single-spaced 10-point interline spacing. [Arial, 10 point, normal, justified alignment]
- Research papers should follow the traditional structure of academic publications: (a) abstract; (b) introduction; (c) chapters of discussion (theory, methodology, findings) (d) conclusion. It is indispensable that the research paper should contain correct citations. Both in-text citations and the list of citations should be used in accordance with the APA (American Psychological Association) style



guide. In case of verbatim references, it is also indispensable to provide page number references.
